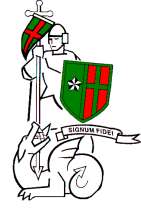

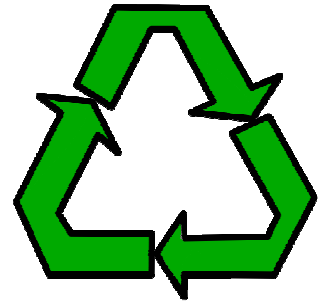

Cake Sale

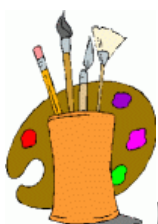
